The college has been declared as linguistic minority institution by the Govt. of Karnataka with effect from 1993. Our college is being reaccredited by NAAC and got "B" Grade.

Mahasatee Arts, Commerce & Science College is situated on the bank of river the Kali, amidst enchanting natural beauty. It is away from the hurry-burry atmosphere of city life providing education friendly solitary environment.

The College has competent team of highly qualified teachers with ample teaching experience headed by the dynamic Principal Dr. M. S. Gaonkar.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Every student should adhere to the following rules and regulations.

1. Possession of personal identity card is compulsory to enter the college premises.
2. Standing and loitering on the verandha of the college is forbidden.
3. Students are forbidden from writing disfiguring or making marks on walls and furniture etc.,

4. The Principal reserves the right to reject or cancel any admission if the particular candidate is found to be misbehaved. The Principal's discretion to grant admission is final.
5. 75% of attendance is compulsory for every student in each subject. If attendance is less than 75% he/she will not be permitted to fill the examination form.
6. No student is allowed to possess or consume ghutka, pan, chewing gum, alcoholic drinks or any other intoxicant. Smoking is strictly prohibited.
7. No student is allowed to communicate any information or write any matter about the college to the press or any media without the prior permission from the Principal.
8. As per section 116 of Karnataka Education Act, 1983, ragging of students is a punishable offence. Ragging is strictly prohibited in the college campus.
9. Fees once paid shall not be refunded. All fees are forfeited on cancellation of admission.
10. The Principal reserves the right to conduct, permit and cancel any function of what so ever nature.
11. If there is hiking in fees or charges by the University or Government, it is the responsibility of the students to pay at the hiked rate.
12. Roll numbers are allotted at the time of admission.
13. In case of ill health or emergency work students have to seek prior permission from the respective class teacher / Principal for his / her remaining absent for the class and he / She has to intimate the same after returning from leave in writing.
14. Possessing and using of mobiles in the premises is prohibited.
15. In all matters the decision of the Principal is final and binding.

FACILITIES

LIBRARY :

Library is the heart of an academic institution. Our college library is housed in separate independent building. Library has got rich collection of 11,500 books in all major disciplines. A good number of International and national journals and periodicals including E journals are subscribed for the benefit of students and staff. Separate BOOK BANK facility is provided for poor and deserving students. Our library is automated and internet, Xerox facility is available.

SPORTS AND GAMES:

As is the saying “A Sound mind in a sound body”, so is the practice. Our College believes that intellectual power must be accompanied by physical fitness. Hence abundant importance is given to sports and games for the physical fitness of students. The college campus has a large playground for cricket, kho-kho, kabaddi, volleyball, tennis & throw-ball courts and athletic items Besides, we got 200m track for runners. As far as indoor game is concerned we have a spacious Gymkhana Hall where indoor games like table tennis, carom and chess are played. Besides, twelve stations Gymnasium service is provided to our students.

LABORATORIES :

Laboratory facility is provided for Science students to conduct practical related to their subjects. Our college got three separate well furnished laboratories for Chemistry, Botany and Zoology subjects.

COMPUTER LABORATORY :

There has been rapid change in computer technology over past several years. Today computers are used effectively in the field of higher education. The Karnataka University, Dharwad has introduced computer application as one of the compulsory subjects to B.A., B.Com., B.Sc., students under semester system. Hence our college established a well-furnished computer lab with good number of computers. All students make use of this lab as per the arrangements in the time table.

INTERNET FACILITY:

To help students access to effective updated knowledge free internet facility is provided in Computer Lab. & Library.

XEROX FACILITY:

Xerox facility is also made available in the college. It helps remarkably to take out any number of copies of any document related with administrative communication. On the other hand college students also make use of this facility at the time of their admission, filling of examination forms and on other occasions.

HOSTEL FACILITY:

Hostel facility is provided to both boys & girl students. Staff members works as the welfare officer and shoulders the responsibility of student's welfare. This department helps students during the course of their study in every respect.

SCOUT & GUIDES - ROVERS UNIT :

Option is kept open for our students to join scout & Guides - Rover Unit

TRANSPORTATION FACILITY:

Transportation facility is provided to staff & students.

NSS UNIT:

To inculcate a sense of service among youths (Students) to their fellow beings, society and nation, National service Scheme has been functioning effectively in our college since the establishment of college. Our unit bagged the “Best Unit” State award in the year 1989. 50 students are enrolled every year in NSS unit for the period of two year. Besides regular activities, which is undertaken on Sundays, unit also undertakes special camp programme for 07 days. The motto of NSS is to develop all round personality of students.

NCC Unit :

With the motto of unity and discipline NCC unit is functioning in our college from the year 1989. The total strength of our 6/29 coy is 120. Two parades of two hours each are conducted weekly. During an academic year 20 parades are conducted for six months from August to January. The parade day each cadet is served with refreshment. Cadets are given training in drill, weapon handling, map reading, first aid, adventure activity etc. They have also got opportunity to attend various camps within the country and outside the country.

STUDENT WELFARE DEPARTMENT:

Student welfare department aims at creating and providing opportunities for the welfare of students who are admitted. At the college level this department works in association with student welfare Department, Karnataka University, Dharwad. One of the teaching staff is in charge of the Department.

PLACEMENT CELL:

The role of Placement in the career of students is really remarkable. Our Placement cell is actively working in guiding the students for better career after their graduation. It arranges programmes for counseling and placement. It also works as an information bureau for the betterment of students.

COLLEGE ASSOCIATIONS :

It is the routine of our college to form various associations in the beginning of academic year. We form the associations like - union, Gymkhana, These associations are headed by a staff member. These associations are shouldered the responsibility of organizing annual sports meet, annual day celebration guest lectures, various functions, NSS camps, purchasing of books and magazines for library and also to assist the principal in her administration.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE :

In order to encourage literary taste among the students, college publishes magazine SAIROBA. The magazine contains various articles, poems, and thoughts & views of our students as well as staff members.

MEDICAL CHECKUP:

“Health is wealth: A healthy student can always have healthy education. Keeping this in mind our college arranges medical checkup programmes every year for the students as well as members of staff.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

GOVERNMENT FREESHIPS, FEE CONCESSIONS

- Students studying in our college receive financial assistance in the form of Government scholarships and fee concession. The central and State Government award these free ships under various schemes to SC/ST/BC/GM children of service personal and freedom fighters and physically handicapped students. Eligible students apply for this scholarship in the prescribed form giving all the necessary details.
- Free pass facility to deserving students is provided to outside students.
- SC/ST/OBC (Excluding creamy layer) & minority are provided special scholarship under UGC Scheme.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

By the instructions of the collegiate education department for the current academic year 2016-17 online admission process is followed. Students seeking admission can fill up their forms online after going through our college prospectus carefully. As our college is a rural college irrespective of lower percentage of students we admit every candidate who has applied. Interview is also conducted for admission.

The students who have been transferred or migrated from a college other than Karnataka University, Dharwad, should produce eligibility certificate from the respective University / Board.

All admissions made by the college are provisional and subject to the confirmation by the Karnataka University, Dharwad.
